Action Plan to Combat Deforestation

Started in November 2021, the plan consists of a set of actions and goals with the objective of intensifying the fight against the illegal suppression of native vegetation in the State, in a complementary manner and aligned with the Annual Inspection Plan (PAF).

- ❑ Goal: Reduce illegal Deforestation continuously, reaching zero by 2028
- ❑ Strategies: Increase in the number of inspections to Combat Deforestation; Reduction of the period between detection of deforestation and inspection; “Minas Against Deforestation” – Mutual technical cooperation with municipalities with the highest rates of deforestation and environmental violations for the joint development of preventive and educational actions; Monitoring and Intelligence Actions for greater effectiveness and assertiveness of inspection actions.
- ❑ Main monitoring indicators: Deforestation alerts (monitors the effectiveness of inspections) and Inspection with Infractions (monitors the assertiveness of detection)

From January to September 2023, there was a 25.00% reduction in deforestation alerts compared to the same period of the previous year. In 48.00% of the activities inspected, infractions were found.
