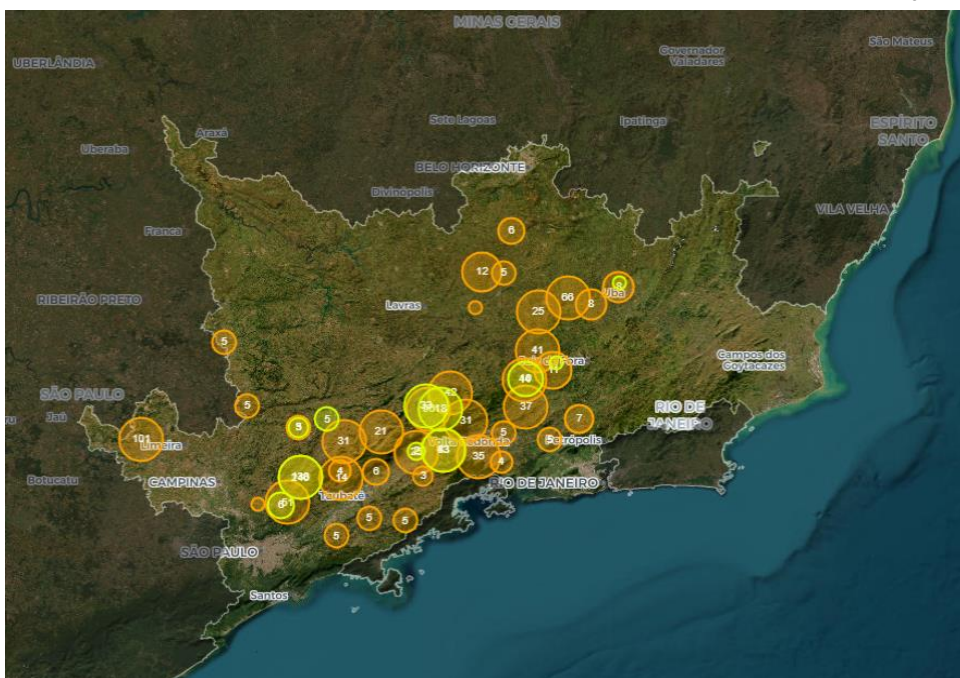
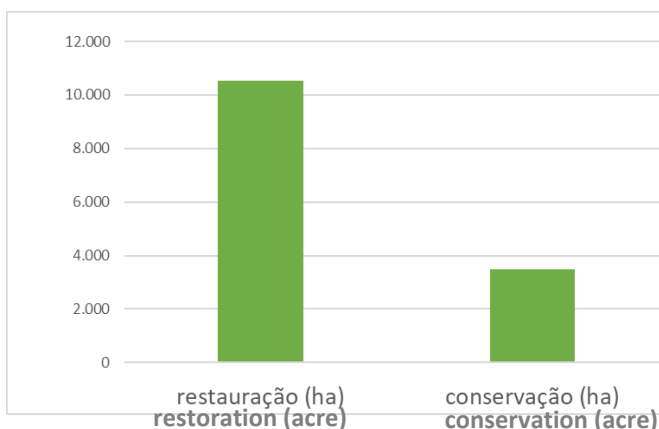

Mantiqueira Conservative Plan

The Mantiqueira Conservation Plan is a collective initiative, which unites agents in the public sphere, in the third sector, in educational institutions and in the private sector towards the same objective: promoting the restoration of the forest landscape in the region of influence of Serra da Mantiqueira.

The main objective of the Mantiqueira Conservation Plan is to support the creation of local public policy to promote the restoration of the forest landscape in around 1.5 million hectares in the Serra da Mantiqueira area of influence, in 425 municipalities in the States of Minas Gerais, São Paulo and Rio de Janeiro, through the environmental adaptation of properties.

The graph on the side demonstrates the gain in vegetation cover in the Serra da Mantiqueira region, in which it can be seen that forest restoration has been more effective, reaching 10,537 ha. Conservation actions totaled 3,486 ha. (data extracted on 10/23/2023).



This map presents the Serra da Mantiqueira region and the distribution of restoration and conservation actions carried out in the territory.

- In yellow are the areas destined for conservation;
- In orange are the areas where restoration actions were carried out.
