STATE CLIMATE ACTION PLAN – PLAC MG

Race to Zero Strategic Project: Minas Gerais State Climate Action Plan (PLAC-MG)

The State Climate Action Plan of Minas Gerais is the strategic instrument that establishes the measures and mechanisms necessary to accelerate investment and implementation of adaptation solutions to the effects of climate change and achieve neutrality of Greenhouse Gas – GHG emissions by 2050 in the state territory, through a set of actions, sub-actions and goals agreed with the bodies of the state Government structure, which will lead its execution according to agreed deadlines. Composed of 28 sectoral actions, 103 sub-actions and 199 goals, the Plan includes mitigation, adaptation, innovation and climate justice actions.

Due to its importance at a local and even international level, PLAC-MG was included in the portfolio of strategic projects of the Government of the State of Minas Gerais, which made it necessary to list a priority set of viable goals for systematic monitoring by senior management of the Government and, jointly, accelerate the trajectories of neutrality and resilience. After selection, there were a total of 41 priority goals.

Strategic Project Objectives

- Enable systematic monitoring by senior management of the MG Government of the execution of priority goals of the PLAC-MG addressed to the Leading Bodies;
- Accelerate the trajectories of GHG emissions neutrality and resilience of the state territory.

Selecting priority goals

- Greater impact on sectoral trajectories of the neutrality scenario
- Urgency of actions and goals to advance the adaptation scenario and reduce vulnerability
- Discussions held with State Government bodies and entities
