CONSERVATION

Conservation Units - UC

Among the environmental protection strategies, the creation of conservation units stands out. The data collected to calculate the IDPA reveal that the percentage of conservation units in relation to the total area of Minas Gerais has been increasing over the years, such that this indicator, which represented 9.74% of the total area of Minas Gerais in 2015, in 2021 it represented 9.85%.

In this sense, it is worth highlighting that, based on data from 2023, there are 95 Conservation Units in the State, 76 of which are for Full Protection and 19 for sustainable use, of which 58 have a Management Plan. As for private natural heritage reserves (RPPN), there are 284 in the State.

- ✓ 95 conservation units under IEF management;
- ✓ Significant increase in the protected area in the State compared to 2015;
- ✓ 284 RPPNs protecting an area of 113.58 thousand hectares;
- ✓ 2.38 million hectares are State areas protected in conservation units.
