AGRO + VERDE – Triângulo Mineiro and Alto Paranaíba

The AGRO + VERDE Project is the result of a partnership between the Faemg Senar System (Federation of Agriculture and Livestock of the State of Minas Gerais) and Cargill, with the support of the Rural Producers Unions. It is aimed at farmers who wish to voluntarily repair environmental liabilities on their property.

The main objective of the project is to promote the sustainable use of farms through practices aimed at the recovery of degraded pastures, permanent preservation areas, and legal reserves (specific areas that Brazilian farms must legally preserve).

The farmer receives technical assistance for 18 months, for the restoration of native vegetation in the necessary areas and in the recovery of degraded pastures. In addition, recovery projects are developed to guide the producer in the restoration process. The producer also receives inputs such as limestone, formulated fertilizers, fence posts, wire, seedlings and seeds of native species, among others.



Results up to September 2024



- **572.7** hectares of native vegetation recovered, with the goal of reaching 1,104 hectares and 100 rural producers by the end of the Project.



- **80,000** seedlings and **1,475** kg of seeds of native species.
- **64** km of fence for vegetation protection.



- **560** hectares of degraded pastures recovered.
- **150.4** tons of fertilizer and **1,300** tons of limestone.
