## MUNICIPAL CLIMATE COMPLIANCE

### Climate in Practice tool, in cooperation with France

Climate in Practice is a tool that seeks to support the municipal administrative sphere in the elaboration of its strategic climate public policies, willing to advance in reducing vulnerability and increasing resilience in the face of new climate conditions. It allows raising awareness and guiding municipal agents in the development of adaptation and mitigation actions, but it can also be used to review and update existing policies and actions and determine short, medium and long-term strategies.

The Tool is composed of:

- A spreadsheet to assist the implementation of climate action and to support the monitoring of action progress;
- A user guide detailing how the Tool works and a document with frequently asked questions;
- Eight thematic sheets containing a detail of each proposed action, so that the municipality knows what to do and how to do it:

In 2024, the methodology was updated and four workshops were organized to present the tool. In total, there were 120 participants, with 18 municipalities represented, most of them with an extreme, very high or high vulnerability index to climate change.
