FIP Rural Landscapes Project in the Tijuco River Basin

Developed in 7 states, in Minas Gerais the Project is executed in the Tijuco River basin, in "Triangulo Mineiro" region. It is financed with Forest Investment Program resources, managed by the World Bank and coordinated by the Brazilian Forest Service/Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Supply. Senar is the executor, providing Technical and Management Assistance to farmers for 2 years.

Technical assistance operates with guidance for environmental recovery, increased productivity and income, management improvements and low-carbon agricultural practices (ABC*), in properties that operate in dairy or beef cattle farming.

To date, the project has invested R\$ 18,865,000.00 in Technical and Management Assistance (AT&G), and has already achieved the result of 37.2 thousand hectares of recovered area, accounting for pasture areas and native vegetation areas, and recoveries carried out with farmers own resources, with an estima _____ of R\$ 120,091,000.00.





Results









- **2,722** rural families assisted;
- > 2,000 farms aided with CAR (Rural Environmental Registry) review;
- **980** native vegetation seedlings donated;
- 6,700 hectares of native vegetation with the adoption of conservation and environmental restoration practices;
- **30,500** hectares of degraded pastures with the adoption of *ABC practices, which remove CO₂ and are essential for climate adaptation and resilience.
