### Responsible Farmer Program

The Program aims the continuous improvement of agribusiness units within various production chains. This is achieved without compromising their governance while making them more sustainable in terms of social, environmental, health, and safety aspects for rural workers.

It reaches farms of different sizes, cooperatives, associations, and others seeking to improve the management of their properties. This is done by complying with labor, safety, health, and environmental regulations, assessing their compliance, raising awareness among participants, and contributing to sustainability.

An initial diagnosis of the property identifies its weaknesses and necessary measures. Subsequently, individual guidance and corrective actions take place, and a new diagnosis identifies the improvements already achieved. Upon reaching the determined score, a "Responsible Farmer" seal is granted to the establishment for the current year.



### Results



- Improvement of social and environmental management in rural properties.
- Adaptation and improvement in health and safety at work on farms.



- Promotion of best practices on farms, associations, mills, cooperatives, etc.
- Credibility of the reputation of the responsible farmer with stakeholders.



- Guided adaptation, strengthening sustainability and social responsibility in farms.
- It also covers training on regulations, with **1,512** people already trained.
