

Raízen x SEDE Technical Cooperation Agreement

Minas Gerais has encouraged and promoted actions aimed at developing the sustainable mobility sector, directing public policies towards alternatives for decarbonizing the transport sector.

In this context, at the beginning of 2024, a Technical Cooperation Agreement was signed between SEDE and Raízen Power, a renowned company in the production of 100% renewable energy. The main objective of the partnership is to install charging hubs to serve electrified car consumers.

Future Mobility Hub Project

SEDE's role is to promote partnerships for the installation of electric-vehicle charging stations in strategic locations to serve society, starting at Confins Airport, passing through the Administrative City of Minas Gerais, UFMG and strategic points in Belo Horizonte.

Minas Gerais has become a reference for Raízen Power in market strategies with the support of the public administration, and joining forces between the public and private sectors strengthens decarbonization actions for transport.

Initial Outcomes

- In April 2024, at the partner's gas station on Av. do Contorno, Posto Oceano, opened the first charging station.
- Discussions have begun with Belo Horizonte City Hall, Mineirão Stadium and Confins Airport.

Mineirão Stadium and Confins Airport are in the project production and negotiation phase.

Highlight: In order to measure the target and also understand the behavior of the electrified vehicle value chain, the Logistics Development Department developed Brazil's first Electric Mobility B.I in partnership with the Brazilian Electric Vehicle Association (ABVE).
